Reconciliation of April 2019 Financial Statements: Financial statements presented at the May 1st Intergroup Meeting were not reconciled to the final April 30, 2018 Wells-Fargo bank statement; because the final April bank statement was not yet available. The April 30th bank statement has been received. The April bank statement was reconciled; and, the final April financial statements were generated.

May 2019 Financial Statement Comments:

- **Literature & Merchandise Sales** of \$3,735.13 when compared to May 2018 of \$5,274.59 were down by 29.2%. Credit card sales as a percentage of total sales has increased over recent years; and, accounted for 68.7% of total Literature and Merchandise Sales during May 2019.
- **Group Contributions** of \$1,802.38 were down by 26.0% when compared to May 2018 contributions of \$2,434.30.
- **Total Income** for May was \$5,547.51, compared to \$7,931.89 during May 2018.
- **Literature & Merchandise Purchases** during the month were \$2,951.10, compared to \$4,962.03 during May 2018.
- **Total Expenses** during May 2019 were \$6,135.77, compared to \$8,355.60 during May 2018.
- **Total Income** during May 2019 was -\$588.26; and, totaled -\$672.42 in May 2018.

YTD May 2019 Financial Statement Comments: Year-to-date-May 2019 financial statements were distributed and reviewed at the June 5th Intergroup Meeting.

NAI OPERATING FUND BALANCE: The Wells-Fargo account balance for the NAI Operating Fund as of May 31, 2019 was \$6,576.27.

NAI PRUDENT RESERVE FUND BALANCE: The Wells-Fargo account balance for the NAI Prudent Reserve Fund as of May 31, 2019 was \$23,036.74. The May Prudent Reserve Balance was equal to 3.34 months of operating expenses.
