**June 2019 Financial Statement Comments:**

- **Literature & Merchandise Sales** of \$3, 073.14 when compared to June 2018 of \$4,059.06 were down by -24.3%. Credit card sales as a percentage of total sales accounted for 59.8% of total Literature and Merchandise Sales during June 2019.
- **Group Contributions** of \$1,101.00 were down by -10.3 % when compared to June 2018 contributions of \$1,227.27.
- **Total Income** for June was \$4,214.14, compared to \$5,307.33 during June 2018.
- **Literature & Merchandise Purchases** during the month were \$750.16, compared to \$415.32 during June 2018.
- **Total Expenses** during June 2019 were \$4,052.56, compared to \$5,467.46 during June 2018.
- **Net Ordinary Income** during June 2019 was \$161.58; and, totaled -\$150.13 in June 2018.
- **Net Other Income** from the June Intergroup Picnic totaled \$124.66.
- **Net Income** totaled \$286.24 during June 2019 and -\$419.61 during June 2018.

**YTD June 2019 Financial Statement Comments:** Year-to-date-June 2019 financial statements were distributed and reviewed at the July 3<sup>rd</sup> Intergroup Meeting.

**NAI OPERATING FUND BALANCE:** The Wells-Fargo account balance for the NAI Operating Fund as of June 30, 2019 was \$7,029.28.

**NAI PRUDENT RESERVE FUND BALANCE:** The Wells-Fargo account balance for the NAI Prudent Reserve Fund as of June 30, 2019 was \$23,037.68. The June Prudent Reserve Balance was equal to 3.59 months of operating expenses.

**g. Treatment/Accessibility**

District 20 treatment committee meets on 1st Thursday of the month 7 P.M. at 24 hour club in Naples.

The last meeting was on June 6th and the next meeting is rescheduled to July 11th from July 4th.

District 20 serves 3 treatment centers and the Detox at Naples Community Hospital. All rotated treatment meeting commitments are for 6 months at a time July through December and January through June. We have just completed the mid year rotation and more than half the 25 weekly meetings rotated this past week.

a. Hazelden Betty Ford, has 4 weekly meetings on Saturday, Sunday, Monday & Thursday. Coordinator, Tom H., has 4 groups with commitment for 6 months at a time. They are July through December and January through June. The Group Chair is responsible for providing

speakers and chairs to conduct the meetings. The facilities require that all participants have at least 1 year of sobriety, have a sponsor and have completed the steps. Each meeting has at least 2 attendees and 8 to 10 members attend this facility each week.

- b. David Lawrence center has 9 meetings each week and 1 monthly **Bridging the Gap** meeting. The Coordinator is John B. who coordinates with the Facility Director and 9 group chairs responsible for arranging speakers for each of the detox meetings. Three other meetings are open beginner discussion meetings, held at the facility. Approximately 40 A.A. Members attend meetings at DLC each week. Members who speak are suggested to have at least 6 months sobriety and anyone who was a DLC client is asked to have 1 year before speaking at the facility.
- c. The Willoughs has 4 speaker beginner's meetings each week. Coordinator **Cuba**. Each meeting has at least 2 attendees and 10 A.A. Members each week attend meetings in the Willough Facility.
- d. Naples Community Hospital, (N.C.H.) has 7 meetings a week, each evening at 7 P.M. in 4th Floor South Detox Center. The NCH coordinator recently resigned due to health considerations and this is an open service opportunity. Usually 3 members attend each meeting at NCH Detox and 20 members a week attend meetings in the facility.
- h. Approximately 90 district 20 AA members attend Treatment Facility meetings each week.
- i. Bridging the Gap reports for the quarter: Men.12 calls 8 bridges. Women 4 calls 4 bridges. Three meetings held at the David Lawrence Center Treatment with 20 attendees. All meetings in all 4 facilities include Bridging the Gap information.
- j. Literature: The treatment committee purchases and distributes 5 to 7 cases of soft cover Big books to NCH, Willough and DLC.
- k. We also regularly stock 5 A.A "Pamphlet Racks" in the three treatment facilities for both detox and rehab at DLC and Willough. Hazelen has Rehab only.
